

**Notes:**

- 1- Other than exceptions in the Regulation, explicit consent of Personal Data Subject shall be obtained and data transfer or transport shall not result in jeopardizing national security or the State's higher interest.
- 2- According to Article (4) of the Cyber Defense Center System issued by Royal Decree No. (64/2020), obtaining the approval of the Cyber Defense Center shall be necessary in the event of processing sensitive personal data.
